

## ***Baker & Taylor ONIX File Requirements – Print Books***

**Baker & Taylor’s ONIX file requirements:** we accept version 2.0 and version 2.1; your discount (or discount code) needs to be in tag J149 for version 2.0 and tag J364 for version 2.1. (If you use a discount code, we need a translation table)—if you have a flat discount with B&T this won’t be necessary. During the testing phase, we request that you continue to provide your title information in the current manner or use the attached template and instructions.

**Baker & Taylor ONIX data requirements:**

- Title information must be consistent – no editions, volume numbers, physical formats, series titles, etc. should be included with the title. Subtitles must be in appropriate ONIX tag.
- Publication dates must coincide with status NP (not yet published) - the date shouldn’t be in the past with an NP status.
- The spelling of the publisher name and imprint name must be consistent throughout the file.
- If B&T’s discount varies per market, binding, etc. we must have a discount code along with a code translation table.
- Each title must have at least 1 valid BISAC code from the latest code list. If more than one, the most specific must be first. We can take up to 3.
- Juvenile titles must have grade or age ranges
- Mixed media packages must identify components included.
- Author name must be provided as “last name, first name”.
- Complete imprint names must be provided.
